PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL STORM "INDAY" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT **840 KM** EAST OF BASCO, BATANES (**19.4°N, 129.9°E**) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF **65 KM/H** NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO **80 KM/H**. MOVING ALMOST STATIONARY, SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON.

WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cavite particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Cañas, Ilang-ilang and Imus • Rizal particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa • Batangas particularly in Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Kapumpang, Rosario-Lobo and Upper Bolbok (Lawaya). • Quezon particularly in Upper Umiray, Lower Bolbok (Lawaya), Malaking-Ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsanjan, Yabahaan, Bigol, Guinhalinan, Vinas, Calauag, Pandanan, Sta. Lucia, Lugan Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island) and Upper Kilbay – Catabangan • Laguna particularly Pagsanhan, Pila-Sta.Cruz, San Juan, and San Cristobal.

WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Oriental Mindoro particularly Malaylay-Baco, Pulang Tubig, Mag-asawang Tubig, Butas, Pula, Agsalin, Bansud, Samagui, Bongabon, Baroc, Bulalacao, and Balete. • Palawan particularly Abongan, Lian, Barabakan, Rizal, Caramay, Langogan, Babuyan, Bacungan, Iwahig Penal, Inagauan, Aborlan, Malasgao, Apurauan, Baton-baton, Aramayawan, Ihawig, Panitian, Pulot, Lamakan, Kinlugan, Eraan, Tiga Plan, Malabangan, Ilog, Bansang, Conduaga, Culasian, Iwahig (Brookes), Okayan, Canipan and Busuanga, Coron. • Occidental Mindoro particularly in Abra de Ilog, Cagaray, Labangan, Magbando, Lunintao, Anahawin, Monpong, Amnay, Pola, Pagbahan, Mamburao, and Ibod.
