<b>FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL</b>	<b>Light to occasionally moderate rains and thunderstorms</b>
<b>WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<b>Rivers and Tributaries in:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>MAGUINDANAO</b> particularly Nituan, Mindanao, Dalika, Allah, Buluan, Mataber, Ylang, and Lower MLang.</li><li>• <b>LANAO DEL SUR</b> particularly Dapao and Mataling.</li><li>• <b>BASILAN</b> particularly Gubauan and Gumalarang.</li><li>• <b>SULU</b> rivers and its tributaries.</li></ul>

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are advised to take necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
