ACTION/S TAKEN:

NDRRMC Advisory on General Flood Advisories was disseminated to OCD Regional Offices III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII and VIII through facsimile, SMS, and website for further dissemination to respective LDRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.

You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
