PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE EYE OF TYPHOON "HANNA" {LEKIMA} WAS LOCATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 1,085 KM NORTH OF EXTREME NORTHERN LUZON (30.1°N, 120.4°E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 90 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 130 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTH NORTHWEST AT 20 KM/H. MEANWHILE, TYPHOON 'KROSA' WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 1,995 KM EAST OF EXTREME NORTHERN LUZON (22.8°N, 141.1°E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 120 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 175 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTHWEST VERY SLOWLY. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WHOLE COUNTRY.

Maria and Buaya.• LA UNION - particularly Amburayan, Bararo, Lower Bauang and Aringay.• ILOCOS NORTE - particularly Bulu, Banban, Bacarra-Vintar, Laoag and Quiaoit.

PUBLIC WARNING:

People living near the mountain slopes and low-lying areas near the above-mentioned river systems; cities and municipalities; and the **Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs)** concerned are **advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides and to take precautionary measures and appropriate actions.**

Further, local flooding is possible in urban and agricultural areas due to or drainage system and impounding water.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
