### PRESENT WEATHER:

Southwest Monsoon affecting the western sections of Luzon and [Visayas](#). Meanwhile, at **3:00 PM today**, the eye of Typhoon "SOULIK" was located based on all available data at **1,915 KM** east of Northeast of extreme Northern Luzon (**24.8 °N, 140.0 °E**) [OUTSIDE PAR] with maximum sustained winds of **140 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **170km/h**. It is almost stationary.
