**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 3:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Depression "URDUJA" (KAI-TAK) was estimated based on all available data at 230km Northwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (10.2°N, 116.7°E) with maximum winds of 45 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 60 km/h. It is forecast to move West at 15 km/h. Tail-end of a cold front affecting the eastern section of Northern Luzon.
