PRESENT WEATHER:

At **3:00 PM today**, the center of Tropical Storm "Jolina" was estimated based on all available data at 130 km southeast of Casiguran, Aurora (**15.4°N, 122.9°E**) with maximum sustained winds of **80 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **95 km/h**. It is forecast to move west northwest at **19 km/h**.
