No. 01 for Region IV-A (CALABARZON)

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Quezon particularly Upper Umiray, Lower Bolbok, (Lawaya), Malaking-Ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsanjan, Yabahaan, Bigol, Guinhalinan, Vinas, Calauag, Pandanan, Sta. Lucia, Lugan, Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island) and Upper Kilbay-Catabangan.

No. 05 for Region IV-B (MIMAROPA)

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Palawan particularly Abongan, Lian, Barabakan, Rizal, Caramay, Langogan, Babuyan, Bacungan, Iwahig Penal, Inagauan, Aborlan, Malasgao, Apurauan, Baton-Baton, Aramayawan, Ihawig, Panitian, Pulot, Lamakan, Kinlugaan, Eraan, Tiga Plan, Malabangan, Ilog, Bansang, Conduaga, Culasian, Iwahig (Brookes), Okayan, Canipan and Busuanga, Coron.• Oriental Mindoro particularly Malaylay-Baco, Pulang Tubig, Magasawang Tubig, Butas, Pula, Agsalin, Bansud, Samagui, Bongabon, Baroc, Bulalacao and Balete.• Occidental Mindoro particularly Abra de Ilog, Cagaray, Labangan, Magbando, Lunintao, Anahawin, Monpong, Amnay, Pola, Pagbahan, Mamburao and Ibod.• Marinduque particularly Tawiran-Tagum (Marinduque) and Boac.• Romblon all rivers and its tributaries.

No. 15 for Region V (Bicol Region)

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masbate particularly Lanang, Mapayawan, Mandaong, Asid, Malbag, Guiom, Nainday, Daraga, Nauco (Aguada) and Beleno. • Albay particularly Guinale and Upper Donsol. • Sorsogon particularly Lower Donsol, Ogod, Putiao, Cadacan, Banuang-Duan, Fabrica (Tugbugan) and Matnog. • Camarines Norte particularly Labo and Daet Basud. • Camarines Sur particularly Lower Kilbay Catabangan, Ragay, Tinalmud, Tambang and Lagonoy. • Catanduanes particularly Cabuyan, Bato and Pajo.

No. 08 for Region VI (Western Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to occasionally moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Antique particularly Sibalom, Ipayo, Cagaranan, Palawan, Cairauan, Dalanas and Tibiao. • Capiz particularly Panay, Mambusao, Panay Malinao, Alingon, and Balantian. • Iloilo - Rivers and its tributaries particularly Pinantan, Barotac, Akalaygan, Jalaud, Jalano, Jagdong, Jalaur, Lamunan, Jaro-Agaman, Sibalom, and Guimbal. • Aklan particularly Ibajay, Aklan, and Jalo. • Negros Occidental particularly Malogo, Sicaba, Grande, Himocan, Danao, Upper Tyabanan, Sipalay and Lower ilog.

No. 14 for Region VIII (Eastern Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Northern Samar particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Mano and Gamay. • Leyte particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan and Binahaan. • Southern Leyte Bisay, Himbangan and Pandan. • Eastern Samar particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga and Sulat. • Samar particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan. • Biliran rivers and its tributaries.
