PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm "URDUJA" (KAI-TAK) was estimated based on all available data at 70 km West Southwest of Cuyo, Palawan (10.7°N, 120.4°E) with maximum winds of 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 75 km/h. It is forecast to move West at 18 km/h. Tail end of a cold front affecting the eastern section of Southern Luzon.

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p>Rivers and Tributaries in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Antique particularly Sibalom, Ipayo, Cagaranan, Palawan, Cairauan, Dalanas and Tibiao. • Capiz particularly Panay, Mambusao, Panay Malinao, Alingon and Balantian. • Negros Occidental particularly Malogo, Sicaba, Grande, Himocaan, Danao, Upper Tyabanan, Sipalay and Lower Ilog. • Iloilo particularly Pinantan, Barotac, Akalaygan, Jalaud, Jalano, Jagdong, Jalaur, Lamunan, Jaro-Agaman, Sibalom and Guimbal. • Aklan particularly Ibjay, Aklan and Jalo.

No. 14 for Region VII (Central Visayas)

WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	<p>Rivers and Tributaries in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cebu particularly Kotkot, Mananga, Guinabasan, Balamban and Sapang Dako. • Bohol particularly Inabanga, Ipil, Matulid, Loboc and Abatan • Negros Oriental particularly Libertad, Tanjay, Candugay, Siaton, Cautitan, Sipocong, Bayawan, Pagatban and Lower Tyabanan.

No. 14 for Region VIII (Eastern Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to occasional moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms.

Rivers and Tributaries in:

- **Eastern Samar** particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga and Sulat.
- **Leyte** particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan and Binahaan.
- **Northern Samar** particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Mano and Gamay.
- **Southern Leyte** particularly Bisay, Himbangan and Pandan.
- **Samar** particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan.
- **Biliran** rivers and its tributaries
