People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems are still advised to take precautionary measures. Concerned Regional and Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (R/LDRRMCs) are still advised to take necessary preparedness measures and possible response actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
