FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: Northern Samar – particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Mano and Gamay. Leyte – particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan, and Binahaan Southern Leyte – particularly Bisay, Himbangan and Pandan. Eastern Samar – particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga and Sulat. Samar – particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan. Biliran
