### PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "Vinta" was estimated based on all available data at 365 km South Southeast of Pagasa Island, Palawan (8.1N, 115.6E) with maximum winds of 120 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 145 km/h. It is forecast to move west at 25 km/h.
