PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE LOW-PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 900 KM EAST OF HINATUAN, SURIGAO DEL SUR (7.9°N, 134.5°E). TAIL-END OF A COLD FRONT AFFECTING EASTERN SECTION OF SOUTHERN LUZON.

FORECAST RAINFALL	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorm.
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries particularly Tuganay, Saug and Simong rivers

With this event and unless significant rain occurs, this is the final General Flood Advisory for this event.


You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
