**PRESENT WEATHER:**

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL STORM "KARDING" (YAGI) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT **1,080 KM EAST OF BASCO, BATANES (22.8 °N, 132.1 °E)** WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF **75 KM/H** NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO **90 KM/HR.** MOVING **WEST SLOWLY.** SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WHOLE COUNTRY.
