At 4:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "Odette" was estimated based on all available data at 285 KM East of Aparri, Cagayan (18.2N, 124.3E) with maximum winds of 55 KM/H near the Center and gustiness of up to 65 KM/H. It is forecast to move west at 30 KM/H.
