At 3:00 PM today, Tropical Depression “URDUJA” was estimated based on all available data at 415 km East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (11.1°N,129.5°E) with maximum winds of 55 km/h and gustiness of up to 65 km/h. It is forecast to move Northwest at 7 km/h.


PUBLIC WARNING:
