**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 3:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Storm "Odette" was estimated based on all available data at 150 KM West of Sinait, Ilocos Sur (17.5N, 119.0E) with maximum winds of 90 KM/H near the center and gustiness of up to 113 KM/H. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 15 KM/H.
