**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At **4:00 AM** today, Tropical Depression “URDUJA” was estimated based on all available data at **175 km** East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (**11.2°N, 127.3°E**) with maximum winds of 55 km/h and gustiness of up to 65 km/h. It is forecast to move **West** at **8 km/h**.
