Iponon, and Alubijid.

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Davao del Sur – particularly Davao, Talomo, Lipadas, Tagulaya Sibulan, Digos and Padada Mainit • Davao Occidental – particularly Panglan, Malita, Batanan (Lais, Lawan, Latuan, Calian, Lamita, Lawayon, Culama, Caburan Bi, Maubio, Karabana, Tubayo, Kayapung, Malala, Capisolo, Tanoman Bi, Tanoman Smal, Kalbay, Butua, Nuin, Butula, Baki, Malagupo, Balagona, Batulaki. • Compostela Valley – particularly Matibo and Hijo. • Davao del Norte – particularly Tagum-Libuganon, Tuganay, Saug, and Lasang. • Davao Oriental – particularly Cateel, Dapnan, Baganga, Mahan-Ub, Manorigao, Caraga, Casauman, Quinonoan, Bagwan, Mayo, Bitanayan, Sumlog, Tangmoan, Dacongbonwa, Kabasagan, Manay, Maya and Sumlao/Cuabo.

No. 03 for Region XII (SOCCSKSARGEN)

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • South Cotabato – particularly Siquil, Makar, and Banaga. • Sultan Kudarat – particularly Tian and Kraan. • Sarangani – particularly Kalaong, Buayan-Malungan, Little Lun, Big Lun, and Gian. • North Cotabato – particularly Libungan, Malasila, Toliman-Dunakling, Maridagao, Kabacan, Mulita, Alkan, Kulaman, Upper Mlang and Pulanggi.

No. 02 for Region XIII (Caraga)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Surigao del Norte – particularly Surigao and Magallanes.• Agusan del Sur – particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonana and Andanan.• Dinagat Islands – particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet• Agusan del Norte – particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos, and Cabdbaran.• Surigao del Sur – particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan, and Bislig.

PUBLIC WARNING:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) concerned advised to be alert for possible flashfloods.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
