**PRESENT WEATHER:**

**AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF THE TROPICAL DEPRESSION "AMANG" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 495 KM EAST OF HINATUAN, SURIGAO DEL SUR (7.9 N, 130.8 E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 45 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 60 KM/H. MOVING NORTH NORTHEAST AT 15 KM/H. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON.**
