At 3:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm "ISANG" was estimated based on all available data at the vicinity of Itbayat, Batanes (20.7°N, 121.8°E) with maximum sustained winds of 80 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 97 km/h. It is forecast to move west at 20 km/h. Southwest Monsoon affecting Luzon and Visayas.
