**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At **3:00 AM today**, the center of Tropical Storm "ISANG" was estimated based on all available data at the vicinity of **Itbayat, Batanes (20.7°N, 121.8°E)** with maximum sustained winds of **80 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **97 km/h**. It is forecast to move west at **20 km/h**. Southwest Monsoon affecting Luzon and Visayas.
