At 3:00 PM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 200 KM East of Catbalogan City, Samar (11.9N, 126.7E). Ridge of high pressure area affecting extreme Northern Luzon. Typhoon JEBI at 3:00 PM Location: 2,205 KM East of Appari, Cagayan (18.3N, 142.5E) (Outside PAR), Maximum Sustained Winds: 205 KM/H, Gustiness: Up to 255 KM/H, Movement: West Northwest at 25 KM/H.

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• ALBAY – particularly Guinale and Upper Donsol.• MASBATE - particularly Lanang, Mapayawan, Mandaong, Asid, Malbag, Guiom, Nainday, Daraga, Nauco (Aguada) and Beleno.• SORSOGON - particularly Lower Donsol, Ogod, Putiao, Cadacan, Banuang-Duan, Fabrica (Tubugan) and Matnog.• CAMARINES NORTE – particularly Labo and Daet Basud.• CAMARINES SUR – Lower Kilbay Catabangan, Ragay, Tinalmud, Tambang and Lagonoy.• CATANDUANES – Cabuyan, Bato and Pajo.

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the **Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils** (LDRRMCs) concerned are **advised to take necessary precautionary measures.**

You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
