FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Dinagat Islands – Malinao Inlet and Gaas• Surigao del Norte – Surigao and Magallanes• Agusan del Sur – Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan, and Andanan• Agusan del Norte – Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos, and Cabadbaran• Surigao del Sur – Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan, and Bislig


People living near the mountain slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the LDRRMCs concerned are advised to take necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
