<b>WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<b>Rivers and Tributaries in:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>SARANGANI</b> particularly Kalaong, Buayan-Malungan, Little-Lun, Big-Lun and Gian</li><li>• <b>SOUTH COTABATO</b> particularly Siquil, Makar and Banaga</li><li>• <b>SULTAN KUDARAT</b> particularly Tian and Kraan</li><li>• <b>NORTH COTABATO</b> particularly Libungan, Malasila, Toliman-Dunakling, Maridagao, Kabacan, Mulita, Alkan, Kulaman, Upper Mlang and Pulanggi</li></ul>

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are advised to take necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
