PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, TROPICAL DEPRESSION “KARDING” WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 1,215 KM EAST OF CALAYAN, CAGAYAN (18.8 N, 133.0 E) WITH MAXIMUM WINDS OF 55 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 65 KM/H. MOVING WEST AT 10 KM/H. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING SOUTHERN LUZON, VISAYAS, AND MINDANAO.

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Zamboanga Sibugay - Rivers and its tributaries particularly Tumaga, Taguite, Tigbao, Digsa, Sanito, Bakalan, Kabasalan and Sibuguey. • Zamboanga Del Sur - Rivers and its tributaries particularly Kamalarang, Tupilac, Labangan and Mapangi.
