PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, TROPICAL STORM "BASYANG" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 190KM EAST SOUTHEAST OF HINATUAN, SURIGAO DEL SUR (8.0N,128.0E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 65KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 80KM/H. IT IS FORECAST TO MOVE WEST NORTHWEST AT 25KM/H. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING NORTHERN AND CENTRAL LUZON.

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eastern Samar – particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga, and Sulat • Leyte – particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan, and Binahaan • Northern Samar – particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Mano, and Gamay • Samar – particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga, and Jibatan • Southern Leyte – particularly Bisay, Himbangan, and Pandan. • Biliran - all rivers and its tributaries.

No. 03 for Region X (Northern Mindanao)

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lanao Del Norte – rivers and its tributaries particularly Mandulog, Agus, Liangan and Maranding. • Misamis Occidental – rivers and its tributaries particularly Clarin, Palilan and Aloran. • Misamis Oriental - rivers and its tributaries particularly Odiongan, Gingoog, Balatocan, Cabulig, Lower Tagalooan, Lower/Middle Western Cagayan, Iponon and Alubijid. • Bukidnon - rivers and its tributaries particularly Upper Tagalooan and Upper/Eastern Cagayan.

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Davao del Sur particularly Davao, Talomo, Lipadas, Tagulaya Sibulan, Digos and Padada Mainit. • Davao del Norte particularly Tagum-Libuganon, Tuganay, Saug and Lasang. • Davao Occidental particularly Panglan, Malita, Batanan, Lais, Lawan, Latuan, Calian, Lamita, Lawayon, Culama, Caburan Bi, Maubio, Karabana, Tubayo, Kayapung, Malala, Capisolo, Tanoman Bi, Tanoman Smal, Kalbay, Butua, Nuin, Butula, Baki, Malagupo, Balagona, Batulaki. • Davao Oriental particularly Cateel, Dapnan, Banganga, Mahan-Ub, Manorigao, Caraga, Casauman, Quinonoan, Bagwan, Mayo, Bitanayan, Sumlog, Tangmoan, Dacongbonwa, Kabasagan, Manay, Maya and Sumlao/Cuabo. • Compostela Valley particularly Matibo and Hijo.

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sultan Kudarat - particularly Tian and Kraan. • Sarangani - particularly Kalaong, Buayan-Malungan, Little-Lun, Big-Lun and Gian. • South Cotabato - particularly Siquil, Makar and Banaga. • North Cotabato - particularly Libungan, Malasila, Toliman-Dunakling, Maridagao, Kabacan, Mulita, Alkan, Kulaman, Upper Mlang and Pulanggi.

No. 04 for Region XIII (Caraga)

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Surigao del Norte particularly Surigao and Magallanes. • Dinagat Islands particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet. • Agusan del Norte particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran. • Agusan del Sur particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan,

	Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan. • Surigao del Sur particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig.
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No. 02 for ARMM (Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to occasionally moderate rains
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> • Lanao del sur - particularly Dapao and Mataling. • Maguindanao - particularly Nituan, Mindanao, Dalika, Allah, Buluan, Mataber, Ylang and Lower Mlang. • Basilan - particularly Gubauan and Gumalarang. • SULU - all rivers and its tributaries.
