PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM Today, the center of tropical depression "HENRY" was estimated based on all available data at 200 km East – Southeast of Calayan, Cagayan (18.8 N, 123.3 E) with maximum sustained winds of 60 KM/H near the center and gustiness of up to 75 KM/H. Moving West at 35 KM/H. Meanwhile, a Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 200 KM East Southeast of Calayan, Cagayan (18.8 N, 123.3 E). Southwest Monsoon affecting the Western Section of the country.

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Antique particularly Sibalom, Ipayo, Cagaranan, Palawan, Cairauan, Dalanas, and Tibiao. • Aklan particularly Ibajay, Aklan, and Jalo. • Iloilo particularly Pinantan, Barotac, Akalaygan, Jalaud, Jalano, Jagdong, Jalaur, Lamunan, Jaro-Agaman, Sibalom, and Guimbal. • Negros Occidental particularly Malogo, Sicaba, Grande, Himocaan, Danao, Upper Tyabanan, Sipalay, and Lower Ilog. • Capiz particularly Panay, Mambusao, Panay Malinao, Alingon, and Balantian
