PRESENT WEATHER:

SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WESTERN SECTION OF LUZON. MEANWHILE, AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE EYE OF TYPHOON SOULIK WAS LOCATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 1,510 KM EAST NORTHEAST OF EXTREME NORTHERN LUZON (26.1° N, 135.4° E) [OUTSIDE PAR] WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 150 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 185 KM/H. MOVING WEST NORTHWEST 15KM/H.


