#### PRESENT WEATHER:

SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WESTERN SECTION OF LUZON. MEANWHILE, AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE EYE OF TYPHOON CIMARON WAS LOCATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 2,000 KM EAST NORTHEAST OF EXTREME NORTHERN LUZON (23.2 °N, 141.1 °E)[OUTSIDE PAR] WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 145 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 180 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTHWEST AT 25 KM/H. TYPHOON SOULIK LOCATION OF THE EYE (3PM): 1,245 KM NORTH NORTHEAST OF EXTREME NORTHERN LUZON (29.9 °N, 128.6 °E)[OUTSIDE PAR] MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS: 160 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER GUSTINESS: 195 KM/H MOVEMENT: NORTHWEST AT 25 KM/H.
