
No. 15 (FINAL) for Region CAR (Cordillera Administrative Region)

LIGHT RAINS	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <p>Abra – particularly Upper Abra, Tineg, Ikmin. Ifugao – all rivers and its tributaries. Apayao – particularly Upper Abulug. Mountain Province – all rivers and its tributaries Kalinga – all rivers and its tributaries Benguet – particularly Upper Bauang</p>
