PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today, a Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 145 KM East Northeast of Butuan City, Agusan del Norte (9.3 N, 126.8 E). Northeast monsoon affecting Northern Luzon and Central Luzon.
