At 3:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 200 KM North Northeast of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (12.2N, 125.7E). Ridge of high pressure area affecting extreme northern Luzon. Typhoon JEBI at 3:00 AM Location: 1,945 KM East of Aparri, Cagayan (19.2N, 140.1E) (Outside Par), Maximum Sustained Winds: 205 KM/H, Gustiness: Up to 255 KM/H, Movement: Northwest at 25 KM/H.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
