### PRESENT WEATHER:

SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WESTERN SECTION OF LUZON. MEANWHILE, AT **3:00 AM** TODAY, THE EYE OF TYPHOON SOULIK WAS LOCATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT **1,360 KM NORTHEAST** OF EXTREME NORTHERN LUZON (**27.1 °N, 133.2 °E**) [OUTSIDE PAR] WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF **160 KM/H** NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO **195 KM/H**. MOVING WEST NORTHWEST **20KM/H**.
