PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression “MARING” was estimated based on all available data at 300 km East of Infanta, Quezon (14.7°N, 124.4°E) with maximum sustained winds of 45 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 60 km/h. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 13 km/h. Meanwhile, at 3:00 pm today, the eye of Typhoon “LANNIE” was located based on all available data at 1,390 km East of Aparri, Cagayan (18.9°N, 134.8°E) with maximum sustained winds of 120 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 145 km/h. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 28 km/h.

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Moderate to occasionally heavy rains
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Aurora particularly Casiguran, Aguang and Lower Umiray.

No. 02 for Region IVA (CALABARZON)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cavite particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Cañas, Ilang-Ilang and Imus.• Batangas particularly Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Kapumpang, Rosario-Lobo and Upper Bolbok (Lawaya).• Laguna particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta. Cruz, San Juan and San Cristobal.• Quezon particularly Upper Umiray, Lower Bolbok (Lawaya), Malaking-Ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsanjan, Yabahaan, Bigol, Guinhalinan, Vinas, Calauag, Pandanan, Sta. Lucia, Lugan, Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island) and Upper Kilbay – Catabangan.• Rizal particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa.

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Marinduque particularly Tawiran-Tagum (Marinduque) and Boac.• Romblon• Occidental Mindoro particularly Abra de Ilog, Cagaray, Labangan, Magbando, Lunintao, Anahawin, Monpong, Amnay, Pola, Pagbahan, Mamburao and Ibod.• Oriental Mindoro particularly Malaylay-Baco, Pulang Tubig, Mag-asawang Tubig, Butas, Pula, Agsalin, bansud, Samagui, Bongabon, Baroc, Bulalacao and Balete.

No. 01 for Region IX (Zamboanga Peninsula)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Zamboanga del Sur particularly Kamalarang, Tupilac, Labangan and Mapangi.• Zamboanga Sibugay particularly Tumaga, Taguite, Tigbao, Digsa, Sanito, Bakalan, Kabasalan and Sibuguey.• Zamboanga del Norte particularly Paro-Dapitan, Dipolog, Dikaya, Golid Duwait, Sindangan, Ingin (Maras), Palandoc, Bucas, Pataug, Quipit, Siocon, Piacan, Anungan, Pangamiran and Sibuco.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
