PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL STORM "KARDING" (YAGI) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 990 KM EAST NORTHEAST OF BASCO, BATANES (24.2 °N, 130.7 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 75 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 90 KM/HR. MOVING NORTHWEST AT 25 KM/H. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WHOLE COUNTRY.

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: La Union – Amburayan, Bararo, Lower Bauang and Aringay. Ilocos Sur – Lower Abra, Silay-Sta. Maria and Buaya. Ilocos Norte – particularly Bulu, Banban, Bacarra-Vintar, Laoag and Quiaoit. Pangasinan – particularly Balincuguin and Alaminos.

No. 9 for Region III (Central Luzon)

FORECAST 12- HR RAINFALL	LIGHT TO MODERATE RAINS
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: Bataan – particularly Balanga and Moron. Zambales – particularly Panatawan, Sto. Tomas, Bucau, Bancul and Lawis. Bulacan – all rivers and tributaries

No. 6 for Region IV-A (CALABARZON)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	LIGHT TO MODERATE WITH OCCASIONALLY HEAVY RAINS
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: Batangas – particularly in Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Kapumpong, Rosario-Lobo and Upper Bolbok (Lawaya). Laguna – particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta.Cruz, San Juan, and San Cristobal. Cavite – particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Cañas, Ilang-ilang and Imus Rizal – particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa

	Quezon – particularly in Upper Umiray, Lower Bolbok (Lawaya), Malaking-Ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsanjan, Yabahaan, Bigol, Guinhalinan, Vinas, Calauag, Pandanan, Sta. FORECAST 12- HR RAINFALL	LIGHT TO MODERATE RAINS
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: Occidental Mindoro – particularly Abra de Ilog, Cagaray, Labangan, Magbando, Lunintao, Anahawin, Monpong, Amnay, Pola, Pagbahan, Mamburao and Ibod.

No. 6 for CAR (Cordillera Administrative Region)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	MODERATE TO HEAVY RAINS
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: Benguet – particularly Upper Bauang Abra – particularly Upper Abra, Tineg, Ikmin Apayao – particularly Upper Abulug Ifugao – all rivers and its tributaries Kalinga – all rivers and its tributaries Mountain Province – all rivers and its tributaries

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the <u>Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils</u> concerned are **advised** to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.
