AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL (MM):

PAST 24 HOURS: 6 MM

FORECAST 24 HOUR RAINFALL: LIGHT TO OCASSIONALLY LIGHT RAINS

PUBLIC WARNING:

Rivers within the basin are still relatively low, however, light to moderate rains are expected over the basin beginning today. Residents and local DRRMCs adjacent to and/or along the abovementioned waterways are advised for possible flashfloods at the river upstream portions and river overflowing at mid-stream sections. Communities near mountain slopes are advice to be alert for possible landslides.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
