No. 03 for ARMM (Autonomous Region of Muslim Mindanao)

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MAGUINDANAO particularly Nituan, Mindanao, Dalika, Allah, Buluan, Mataber, Ylang and Lower Mlang. • LANAO DEL SUR particularly Dapao and Mataling. • BASILAN particularly Gubauan and Gumalarang.
