**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 3:00 PM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **115 km North of Aparri, Cagayan (19.4°N, 121.6°E)**. Meanwhile, another LPA was estimated based on all available at **765 km East Southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (6.9°N, 133.1°E)**. Southwest Monsoon affecting the western section of Luzon.
