PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 105 KM EAST OF CATARMAN, NORTH SAMAR (12.4N, 125.6E). NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON AND VISAYAS.


People living near the mountain slopes and low-lying areas near the above mentioned rivers and the local disaster risk reduction and management councils concerned are advised to take precautionary measures.
