### **PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 3:00 PM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 200 KM East of Catbalogan City, Samar (11.9N, 126.7E). Ridge of high pressure area affecting extreme Northern Luzon. Typhoon JEBI at 3:00 PM Location: 2,205 KM East of Appari, Cagayan (18.3N, 142.5E) (Outside Par), Maximum Sustained Winds: 205 KM/H, Gustiness: Up to 255 KM/H, Movement: West Northwest at 25 KM/H.

### **FORECAST RAINFALL:**

**Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers.**

### **WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED:**

- **TAGUM-LIBUGANON RIVER** and its tributaries particularly Tuganay, Saug and Lasang Rivers.

**With this event and unless significant rain occurs, this is the final general flood advisory for this event.**

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures and monitor the situation in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take precautions and appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions evacuation rather than rescue.
