### PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "QUEENIE" was located based on all available data at **680 km northeast of Basco, Batanes (24.3°N, 127.1°E)** with maximum sustained winds of **125 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **155 km/h**. It is moving north northwest at **20 km/h**.

Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
