FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains
WATER COURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Agusan Del Sur - particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan.• Surigao del Norte - particularly Surigao and Magallanes• Dinagat Islands – particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet• Agusan del Norte - particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran.• Surigao Del Sur - particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig.

With this development and unless significant rain occurs, this is the final general flood advisory for this event.
