PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF SEVERE TROPICAL STORM "HANNA" {LEKIMA} WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 780 KM EAST OF CALAYAN, CAGAYAN (19.2N, 128.9E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 100 KPH NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF 125 KPH. IT IS MOVING NORTH NORTHWEST AT 10 KPH. MEANWHILE, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 310 KM WEST OF IBA, ZAMBALES (15.7N, 117.1E) SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON AND VISAYAS.
