PRESENT WEATHER:

Northeast monsoon affecting Luzon.

No. 06 (Final) for Region V (Bicol Region)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Isolated light rains or thunderstorm
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Albay – particularly Guinale and Upper Donsol.
With this development and unless significant rain occurs, this is the final General Flood Advisory for this event.	

PUBLIC WARNING:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) concerned advised to be alert for possible flashfloods.
