PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 1,245 KM EAST OF APARRI, CAGAYAN (19.1 N, 133.4 E). MEANWHILE, ANOTHER LPA WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 550 KM WEST OF SUBIC, ZAMBALES (14.3 N, 115.2 E). SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING SOUTHERN LUZON, VISAYAS, AND MINDANAO.
