### PRESENT WEATHER:

AT **3:00 PM** TODAY, THE CENTER OF SEVERE TROPICAL STORM "INDAY" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT **945 KM EAST NORTHEAST** OF BASCO, BATANES (**23.3°N, 130.6°E**) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF **90 KM/H** NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO **115 KM/H** MOVING **NORTHWEST SLOWLY**. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON.

### No. 26 for Region III (Central Luzon)

Tomas, Bucau, Bancul, and Lawis</li><li>• <b>Bulacan</b> – all rivers and its tributaries</li><li>• <b>Nueva Ecija</b> – all rivers and its tributaries</li><li>• <b>Tarlac</b> – all rivers and its tributaries</li><li>• <b>Aurora</b> – Casiguran, Aguang and Lower Umiray</li></ul>

**No. 3 for Region IV-A (CALABARZON)**

<b>WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<b><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Cavite</b> particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Cañas, Ilang-ilang and Imus</li><li>• <b>Rizal</b> particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa</li><li>• <b>Batangas</b> particularly in Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Kapumpang, Rosario-Lobo and Upper Bolbok (Lawaya).</li><li>• <b>Laguna</b> particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta.Cruz, San Juan, and San Cristobal</li></ul>

**No. 9 for CAR (Cordillera Administrative Region)**

<b>FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL</b>	<b>Light to moderate with occasional heavy rains and thunderstorms</b>
<b>WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<b><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Abra</b> – particularly Upper Abra, Tineg, Ikmin.</li><li>• <b>Ifugao</b> – all rivers and its tributaries.</li><li>• <b>Apayao</b> – particularly Upper Abulug.</li><li>• <b>Mountain Province</b> – all rivers and its tributaries</li><li>• <b>Kalinga</b> – all rivers and its tributaries</li><li>• <b>Benguet</b> – particularly Upper Bauang</li></ul>

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the **Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils** concerned are **still advised to take necessary precautionary measures.**
