PRESENT WEATHER

At 3:00 PM today, Tropical Depression "AGATON" was estimated based on all available data at 200 km East Northeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (9.0N, 128.0E) with maximum winds of 45 km/ h near the center and gustiness of up to 60 km/ h. It is forecast to move West at 19 km/ h. Northeast monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.
