PRESENT WEATHER:

Southwest monsoon affecting the western section of Luzon. Meanwhile at 3:00 PM today, the low pressure area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 235 km east northeast of Surigao City, Surigao del Norte (10.4°N, 127.5°E).

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• BATAAN particularly Balanga and Moron.• BULACAN rivers and its tributaries.• NUEVA ECIJA rivers and its tributaries.• TARLAC rivers and its tributaries.• AURORA particularly Casiguran, Aguang and Lower Umiray.• ZAMBALES particularly Panatawan, Sto. Tomas, Bucau, Bancul and Lawis.


People living near the mountains slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are advised to take necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
