AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED FROM ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 140 KM SOUTH SOUTHEAST OF PUERTO PRINSESA CITY, PALAWAN (8.6N, 119.2E). **EASTERLIES AFFECTING EASTERN SECTION OF THE COUNTRY.**

**No. 08 (FINAL) for Region X (Northern Mindanao)**

<b>FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL</b>	<b>Light rains and isolated thunderstorms</b>
<b>WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<b><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Lanao Del Norte</b> – rivers and its tributaries particularly Mandulog, Agus, Liangan and Maranding</li><li>• <b>Misamis Occidental</b> – rivers and its tributaries particularly Clarin, Palilan and Aloran</li></ul>
